

A report on field visit of NSS Unit of BBM College to its adopted village on 20th November,2018.

NSS Unit of Bir Bikram Memorial College,with a view to meeting its commitment towards community service and to commemorating the 150th Birth Anniversary of Mohatma Gandhi, has conducted a field visit to the Malaynagar village (adopted village of BBM College), Ward No.-07 on 20th November,2018.

The NSS Unit has conducted an initial survey to understand the basic problems of the area and decide upon the future direction of the community service in the adopted village.

In the first phase of the survey the NSS team investigated on the drinking water facility, waste dumping facility, sanitation condition, road condition and basic cleanliness of the area.

In the second phase, the NSS Unit will conduct survey on literacy level, employment status of the youth and status of women in the Malaynagar village.

Following observations of the first phase of the survey are summarized hereunder.

1. Name of the adopted village - Malaynagar
2. Ward No. - 07
3. Number of family surveyed - 24 (twenty t four)
4. Total number of people interviewed - 131 (one hundred and thirty one)
5. Drinking water facility - i) Most people consume ground water through tube well
ii) Shallow pumps are also used for drinking water purposes.
6. Toilet facility - Pakka latrine - 18
Kachha latrine - 06
7. Solid waste dumping facility - A barren land is earmarked for solid waste dumping of the particular ward.
8. Condition of road -
9. Overall cleanliness - Poor.
